GENERAL

Purpose College is a registered school since 2013 and has an excellent team of educators on board with qualifications and expertise in the environment of teaching students with challenged circumstances. Upon admission each student is evaluated, and the program is planned accordingly to meet his/her needs in order to pass the grade with the best possible outcome. While working within the legal scope and with policies created for the nature of the environment, the student may be taken back into the previous term to better their marks.

While Purpose College work hand in hand with Healing Wings to help each resident on all levels, each student will be on a different level emotionally as well as academically.

Parents/Sponsors will receive an introductory to Purpose College after complete enrolment and evaluation took place. Thereafter a monthly feedback report will be issued per student. This report discusses in depth what the educational wellbeing, goals and concerns are. It also serves as a progression measurement tool.

The year consists of 4 terms which runs with private school terms in Mpumalanga. Students assessments are divided into these terms, and therefore they will write term tests and mid-year as well as final examinations. The curriculum is CAPS based.

Classrooms are divided according to phases - meaning the senior phase in a group, and FET phase in another group. Gr 12 students have their own group and section to work in. The system we follow allows the student to progress at their own pace, with the assistance of our teachers. A timetable is followed daily where different groups are doing a certain subject simultaneously with the specific teacher present.

Grades have their own co-ordinators, who are responsible for feedback and parent communications. Parents are encouraged to direct all educational enquiries directly to the school and not to Healing Wings as it will delay the process.

Educational fees are separate from therapeutic fees. Tuck shop fees falls under Therapeutic fees as the school does not work with the tuck shop. School payments should be made into the account provided on your invoice for schooling with clear reference as provided in red. Statements are sent out monthly, and school fees are payable in advance by the 28th of the month. In case a student is removed prematurely, the registration fees are not refundable.30-day notice required. The accountholder will be charged for a month of schooling in case no notice was given. Only written notice will be recognised.

Students who take subjects that we cannot offer will be evaluated, and in case a subject change can be made this will be required. (the student's needs will be considered in these instances in terms of workload and career goals) Only Afrikaans and English can be offered as languages.

Concessions: Students who had a concession approved at a previous examination board will be granted the same concession only if our examination board approves of it. Language concessions only applies to students born outside of SA or who was residing outside of SA. No other language concessions will be approved.

Students who are on home-schooling programs will be registered in the grade according to the national curriculum requirements as stipulated in the SA Education Act.

School is compulsory for residents in the Youth Program.
