GENERAL

Purpose College was registered as an independent school with the Department of Education in 2013. We have an excellent team of teachers on board who work in collaboration with Healing Wings to help each resident continue their education, under challenging circumstances. Each learner will be on a different level emotionally and academically.

Purpose College follows a hybrid method with both on-site classroom teaching and online lessons. Grades and subjects are taught in different allocated areas with boys and girls separated.

Our academic calendar consists of 4 Terms which are aligned to the Department of Basic Education. Purpose College utilizes IMPAQ as its CAPS curriculum provider and is registered under SACAI (South African Comprehensive Assessment Institute) Assessment & Exam Evaluation board. All Examinations are received and moderated by SACAI.

Each term, learners undertake periodic scheduled tasks, term tests, written and practical assignments (PAT's), as well as midyear and final examinations. Each learner will receive a termly report.

While working within the legal scope and with policies created for the nature of the environment, Purpose College reserves the right to insist that a learner repeat a grade if deemed necessary.

Kindly note, we are an English mainstream school and only offer English and Afrikaans as either Home or First Additional language. If your child/ward is Afrikaans speaking, they will be taught in English, however all textbooks, tasks, and tests can be provided in Afrikaans.

All education related fees are separate from the Therapeutic Program. Tuck shop fees fall under Therapeutic fees. School payments must be made in advance by the 28th of the month into the account stipulated on your invoice with clear reference provided. Statements are sent out monthly. In case a learner is removed prematurely, the registration fees are not refundable. A 30-day notice is required for termination of schooling. The accountholder will be charged for a month of schooling in the case where no notice period is given.



Concessions and exemptions: To combat and overcome Barriers to Learning, parents must apply for concessions and exemptions which Purpose College will submit to SACAI. Language concessions for FET learners (grade 10 - 12) only apply to learners born outside of South Africa. Learners in grade 6 - 9 are required to take Afrikaans. No other language exemptions will be approved.

All applications and administration shall remain the sole responsibility of the parents. Purpose College is only able to guide parents through the process. All confirmation documentation (including and not limited to affidavits, certified passport copies, psychological reports, past school reports, family motivations, SAQA verification of international school reports, and others) need to be provided by the parents upon enrolment.

Learners who were previously granted a concession at a previous SACAI examination board will be granted the same concession only if our examination board approves it and deems it valid. Please ensure all proof and a portfolio of evidence is submitted upon enrollment.

If a concession was previously approved under a different examination board (IEB/DBE), a new application will need to be submitted with all the above documents, as well as a portfolio of evidence of the approved concession/exemption from the previous school.

While working through the above application process, specifically with regards to a language exemption, your child <u>must</u> choose an eighth subject which will replace the second language, if accepted. At the same time your child must also begin Afrikaans in the event the application is denied, in which case your child <u>must</u> continue with Afrikaans.

School is compulsory for residents taking part in the Healing Wings Therapeutic program. Should a learner be expelled from Healing Wings, this learner will be removed from schooling with Purpose College.

PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- Educational fees are separate from therapeutic fees and are payable into the school bank account by the 28th of each month in advance.
 Educational fees are calculated per term but are payable on a monthly basis.
- Registration fees are due within the first week (5 working days) of arrival. Additional unforeseen costs will be covered by sponsor/accountholder.
- All educational fees will be the responsibility of the sponsor/accountholder.
- Should the learner be removed prematurely, a 30-day notice period will be required. In case no written notice was received, the account holder will be charged one month's fees.
- All fees are to be settled timeously. 10% interest will be charged for fees past 60 days overdue. Accounts will be handed over for collection without notice when past 90 days overdue. Legal fees will be added to outstanding amounts.
- Gr 7-11 fees are payable over 12 months. Gr 12 fees are payable over 11 months.
- Payment arrangements will be recognised only when written approval was granted by the financial manager. An Acknowledgement of Debt form will be required to be signed should such approval be granted.
- In the event the learner is not committing to their education, the fees are still payable. (Resistance is a common stage the learner may go through)

Only international students who (for unavoidable reasons), may be permitted to study an alternative curriculum while at Purpose college. Parents/sponsors of international learners will be billed 50% of the above fees, (Excl Registration Fees) and billed for full stationery costs.

Please Note the Following:

- Registration Fees (gr 8 12) includes all registrations with Impaq, SACAI, stationary for the year (excluding art materials). Registration Fees can be paid over 3 months.
- Registration Fees for Grade 7 must be paid by parents to Impaq directly. These learners fall under the Impaq Homeschool system whereby parents are the account holder. Once finalized, parents/sponsors must register their child with the DBE. Kindly note, stationery and art supplies will be billed.
- Monthly Fees are based on 12 months and are to be paid at the beginning of each month
- Term Fee includes a 10% discount only if paid in advance
- Annual Fee includes a 15% discount only if paid in advance
- Textbooks are not included in the fees and must be paid on order. Purpose College will purchase all IMPAQ prescribed textbooks and parents/sponsors will be invoiced separately. Kindly note, no textbooks will be released until payment is made.
- Visual Arts materials are not included in the fees and must be paid on order. (Learners may NOT bring any of the following: Sharpeners. Scissors. Art sculpting tools. Geometry sets. Permanent markers. Correcting fluid)

All FET learners (grade 10 – 12) will be provided with a Purpose College_laptop. These devices are the property of the school and not the learner, and any damage will be charged for. Learners must return these devices to Purpose College upon exit. Laptop usage is determined by behavior and any misuse (social media, music, gaming etc) will result in the removal of the device until further notice.
